Select an additional nine elective hours from upper level MCOM classes not previously used or, with department head approval, upper level hours in THEA, RHET, or GRDS.
4. Additional degree requirements, 32 hours. Consult with faculty advisor. A minor is required; follow respective minor requirements. Select additional electives as needed. Select to ensure completion of 40 upper level hours required for graduation.
5. World language requirements eight hours. Must complete through Beginning II of a world language or equivalent.
